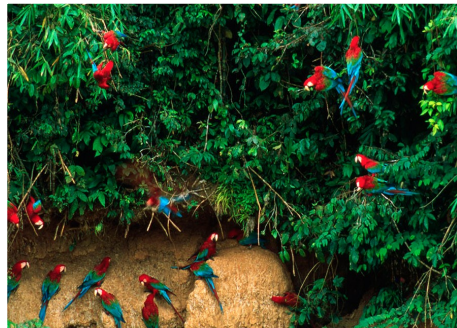


Summer in Peru: Arts & the Environment
