- CSU International Programs (**CSU IP**) are year-long programs. Students apply from all 23 campuses in the CSU system.
- CSULB also offers one semester or year-long programs (**CSULB Direct Exchange**) at partner universities as well as the **Florence Semester** and **London Semester** Programs.
- You pay CSULB tuition, may use Financial Aid (if eligible), and receive CSULB course credit. [Scholarships](#) are also available.
- Once you have selected a program, you are encouraged to meet with your academic advisor to discuss course substitutions.
