Plus a Canadian Forensic Science Field School Certificate

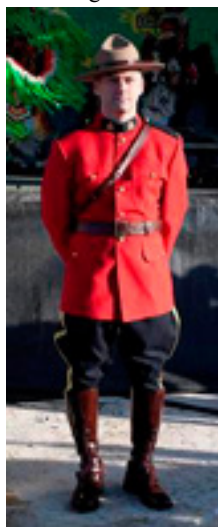
Open to all majors—no prerequisites (earn 3 units from CSULB + 3 units from the British Columbia Institute of Technology in three weeks)

- Take on the role of a forensic scientist by examining evidence recovered from mock crime scenes.
- Learn hands-on examination techniques with different microscopes, crime kits, and devices.
- Study advanced instrumental techniques such as GC, MC, HPLC, FTIR, Stereo-microscope, and SEM.
- Experience a mock trial evaluated by real defense attorneys
- Compare the differences and similarities of U.S. and Canada methods of forensic investigation.
- **Get international forensic science experience for your résumé, jobs, or graduate studies.**

- Tuition for BCIT course (3 units) & lectures by active lab examiners
