

Study Communication and International Justice in the Netherlands

COMM 331 Argumentation and Debate

Dates: **June 11 to July 9**

Eligibility: Anyone can enroll in this course; you do not need to be a student at Long Beach or anywhere else.

Description: The Hague (den Haag), known as “The City of Peace and Justice,” is home to many international courts, including The International Criminal Court and the UN International Court of Justice. Students will participate in debates about international justice and see legal argumentation in action. Course activities include observing court proceedings, meeting with court representatives, visiting libraries, touring an international prison where war criminals are held, visiting the Peace Palace, site of the United Nations’ International Court of Justice, day trips to Delft and Rotterdam, Amsterdam portion of the trip includes all the major museums and attractions.

Location: 5 nights in Amsterdam, 24 days in the Hague, with an optional side trip anywhere in the region

Arrangements: We will stay in private apartments in the Hague and private rooms in a hotel in Amsterdam. The apartments have laundry, wireless internet, kitchens, and other amenities.

Cost: Approx. \$5275 (includes airfare), plus \$921 tuition, plus \$85 insurance.

Payment deadlines: Deposit: \$500 January 26, Trip cost and air fare part 1: \$2387 March 1, Trip costs and airfare part 2: : \$2387 April 13, Tuition: \$921 May 1, Insurance: \$85 May 1
